About the speaker & the presentation



After graduating from the University of Malta in 2008, Marc became a registered Speech-Language Pathologist and started working with the Speech-Language Department in early 2009. Shortly after joining the Department, Marc became a member of the Autism Spectrum Disorders Specialized Division (ASD-SD). Within the ASD-SD, Marc assisted in the development of various assessment and intervention tools for ASD as well as helped to organize numerous Autism Awareness months. In his work as an SLP, Marc's caseload has been predominantly paediatric, with cases of speech impairment, language delay and ASD being amongst the most prevalent aetiologies. In early 2013, Marc became certified in the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule – 2 (ADOS-2). Towards the end of 2013, Marc completed his Master of Education degree with the University of Birmingham and graduated with an overall distinction. Within the Speech-Language Department, Marc has also been delivering training workshops about ASD to parents, teachers and LSAs. In addition to his duties with the Speech-Language Department, Marc has also recently started mentoring Communication Therapy students, as Clinical Educator with the Communication Therapy Department of the University of Malta.
